Introduction of improved modern technology by the organization in agriculture sector has not only multiplied the production of crops but also minimized the rate of migration simultaneously in the realm of women empowerment; contribution of KARRTABYA is incomparably spectacular. Since last 2 decade KARRTABYA has been implicating to stabilize the sustainable development by strengthening the rural economy through improved agricultural practices. 
About us

Who we are

KARRTABYA a renowned non-profit, non-Government voluntary organization of Kalahandi came to existence in the year 1990. It was formed by a group of youths of Kalahandi, who were the members of the local youth club; involved in various organizational and developmental activities of the village. They believed that social transformation could be brought through dedicated work. Pursuing this, the youths worked single mindedly to build up strength within the people of the locality and mobilizing them to fight for social justice. This involvement gradually spread to other villages and became more comprehensive in nature. With the growth of understanding, their involvement became more matured and targeted towards various issues of the region. With the genuine work force the project planning, designing and implementing process it has webbed the projects, in the Kalahandi district as well as outside of it. Key Intervention implemented in 2015-16

1. EDUCATION

To provide an enabling environment for children from disadvantaged communities to access quality education either through Govt. run school, or promoted by KARRTABYA, focus is on all round development of children through education, following are major intervention in the year 2015-2016 to solve educational problem.

1.1 Running Balwadi Center:

KARRTABYA is running 2 Balwadi centers in inaccessible pocket or where there is no Anganwadi Centre. Children those were not able to access the preschool services through Govt. run Anganwadi Centre got preschool & joyful learning. 40 children prepared for schooling by joyful learning from two villages of Pipalpada and Palaspani of Behera and Chhanchanbahali G.P under Dharamgarh Block.

1.2 Special coaching Centre:

KARRTABYA is running 10 upper primary and 3 primary special coaching centers for students in 13 different villages in Junagarh & Dharamgarh Block for slow learners. Learning level of 306 students are gradually improving in English, Mathematics, Odia, Hindi, Science, Social Science and General Knowledge and they are read, write and understanding by adopting different type of playing method.



1.3 Supplementary Education in primary Schools:

KARRTABYA was running 40 supplementary education centers under the collaboration primary school where 2377 children are enrolled. Basically our Education Volunteers are working with the schools for the student of class-1 to class-5th in two shifts one is at morning (6.30 to 9.00 AM) another is within the school time. During the supplementary classes priorities to improvement of Children learning level especially on language & Math. For which we are using different TLM and unique method which is easily adopted by the children and also taking special evening classes in 12 villages with solar light as well as special focus on NAVODAYA coaching classes in some schools.

1.4 Educational support to 7th standard children thru supply of test papers:



It is the new initiative of KAARTABYA 65 test papers were distributed among 7th board exam appears students who are belong to needy family. Which has helped them for appear 7th standard board examination. All the students are passing out with good mark.



1.5 Support to HSC appearing students through test paper:

Proper guidance is very important to the 10th board exam appearing students. KARRTABYA distributed 36 test paper were among HSC appearing students who are belongs to needy family. Which has helped them for appear 10th standard board examination. Mrs. SabitriNaik, Sarapanch was invited and encouraged children. All are passing out with good mark.

1.6 Provide ITE (Integrated Approach of Technology):

KARRTABYA is focuses ITE programme four High schools are Dumerpadarssd high school, Gopalpur boy's high school, Gopalpur girl's high school and Mahulpatnaugs under Thuamul Rampur Block. Through this programme ITE volunteers focusing the project based learning of the children. Objective of this activity is to deepening the knowledge of the children by using different technology like, computer, mobile, camera & browsing of internet. Especially the student making their subject project on Multimedia spread sheet &



digital. The student of ITE has prepared 18 number of project on the subject of Science, Geography, and History. The students are so happy to participate in such type of activities.



2. HEALTH & NUTRITION

2.1 Ensuring school level health camp through NHM program and other govt. program:

KARRTABYA always considers health to be an integral part of education and accordingly addresses the health care needs of the children along with their families to ensure good health. It mainly focuses the children more active and participatory in the class room.

Dr. Biswajit Padhi was invited as resource person. At first Dr. Padhi tried to know about the hygiene practices of the students. Then one by one shared their view. Some of the child were shared their good practices. Then Dr. Padhi told them to how to follow the good hygiene practices. Then Dr. Padhi conducted the health check-up of each participant and provides required medicine.

2.2 Emergency Support to children:

KARRTABYA was provided referral service in Junagarh Block, 15 children and 9 caregivers and 2 siblings are getting emergency health care facilities.

2.3 Awareness on demerits of early marriage:

Early marriage is a major social concern and a violation of children's rights. It deprived the child of his/her childhood. It affects both boys and girls with their higher incidence and more intensity. KARRTABYA was organized awareness programme in Dharmagarh Block in the programme total 6 units achieved in this year. Total 162 participants were participated on that program. Before that program street play on early marriage were conducted. It main focus the facilitator tried to motivate the people to give marry their children in the appropriate age.



2.4 PD Hearth session at community:



KARRTABYA was achieved total 1 unit in this year where 12 non enrolled mothers were participated. The objective of the program was improve the knowledge of mother and child feeding practices towards improve the normal status of children and reduce the child malnutrition. 12 days session was conducted where menu chart was designed and program was continuing. As per the session plan Resource Person were (ANM, ASHA, Doctor) invited. After the 12 days session 3 children gained weight and mothers were marinating health and hygiene practices.

2.5 Building linkage with government line departments and PRIs for construction of HH toilets:

Toilet is very important part of every family because lack of awareness or toilet people go to outside of the field so KARRTABYA take initiatives linkage with government line departments and PRIs for construction of HH toilets buildings and total 5 units achieved this year where the 35 enrolled and 63 none enrolled participant were participated in this programme including the PRI members. Discussion was held on Govt. process of construction of HH toilets and linkages process. As per the Govt. provision people decided to construction of HH toilets. Now a day's 32 community people constructed of HH toilets.



2.6 Demonstration model at Balwadi and AWC for hand washing

with soap:



Through this program we demonstrated the hand washing model at Balwadi and AWC. Total 2 models have demonstrated where 2 enrolled and 12 non enrolled children's mothers were participated. The facilitator orientated regarding the six methods of hand washing with soap, maintain personal health hygiene. We have provided bucket, mug, soap, and surf to Anganwadi Centers. On the spot the mother were practiced that six

methods of hand washing for their children. Now a day's maximum mothers are taking care of child and washing their hands with soap before eating and after toilet.

2.7 Training to Migration returns adolescent boys on SRH:

Migration is a common issue of Kalahandi. So KARRTABYA tack initiative and create aware on SRH among migrant adolescent's boys this training was implemented on dated 18th Oct 2015 at Bogrguda, filed office premises Where 40 youths were participated. Mr. PrasantMajhi was invited as resource person. . He specially focused on three aspects such as; Physical, Mental and Social Change.The main purposes that programme among of 40 youths 25 youth are aware on SRH and how to protect themselves from STD (Sexual Transmitted Diseases).

3. LIVELIHOOD

3.1 Sustainable Agriculture:

To enhance the income opportunity and socio economy standard of landless, marginalized and small holding farmers through commercialization of vegetable production and 100% proper marketabilitythrough collection center, KARRTABYA with the support of Syngenta Foundation has given major focus on promoting agriculture activities like Vegetable Cultivation, Seed production Cultivation through adopting scientific technology. KARRTABYA has stepped forward to strengthen farmer's economy by spreading awareness, developing their skill and providing them all techniques. Since 2006 KARRTABYA had started its journey to stabilize farmers' economy and encourage other to make agriculture as their main occupation through various programs and campaigns. The successful production of high quality hybrid seeds in an area where seed production had never been tried before was a remarkable achievement.

3.1.1 Seed Production: To increase the yield level of farmers, making them economically forward &



developing Kalahandi as a seed production hub in the country, farmers were given good quality of seeds of different companies. KARRTABYA was coverage Current year 372 farmers in 29 villages cultivated hybrid paddy seed in 657.9acre of land in Rabi. Through the help of different System, technical support, better mechanization, new technology in practice has inculcated farmers to go for seed production. Which was increased the income of the family.

3.1.2 CREDIT LINKAGE PROGRAMME:

Credit is known to be the life blood in any activities ,Accessibility to credit linkage uproots and strengthen the activities of the farming community .KARRTABYA was Credit linkage with IDBI bank has really been a supportive strength for the farmers. The Main Purpose supporting farmers with credit is for production enhancement & a better output that can provide them with a better economic & social status. In this base year, the project in conjunction with IDBI bank has led credit to 231 credits for Rs58.90 lacs. Cumulatively the credit status of the project is 508 farmers for Rs 1.31crores.



3.1.3 ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME:

KARRTABYA-SFI has created Agro-Entrepreneur who in deals work for the benefit of the society and ultimately for self –sustainability. There is a vicious circle of connection in between the entrepreneur, the farmers, the traders or the vendors, the bankers. The cash flow is to each group in the circle .Currently there are 16 entrepreneurs who deals in input trading, vegetables vending, supervising and organizing in production activities, bank correspondent, and seed organizer ship. Agro-Entrepreneurs were given training by MANAGE & External agencies & field officers in the project.

3.1.4 Market –LED EXTENSION (MLE):

Market led Extension (MLE) which addressed the issue of market access and led to a direct improvement in farm income .A ready available market helps the marketer for easy deliverance of farm produce. SFI team and its KARRTABYA undertook survey to identify villages in all project region .Initially these villages acted as model projects to generate



awareness amongst other farmers in the region .Currently there are 4 Hubs working in i;eKelia, Taranja, Banjipodar , Godiajore , Kuresin. Collective market programme is a well extendable support for the farmers. 4 hubs developed with 150-200 farmers of nearby villages and also prepared different Farmer Group and each group15-20 farmers. The group members are trained for variety selection through demonstration and trail plot model.

3.1.5 Agriculture Knowledge Centre:



KARRTABYA with its supporting agency established “Agriculture Knowledge centre” in the year 2014 initiated to impart extension knowledge to rural youth. The main motto was to bring Youth back to agriculture, to develop bare foot doctors, to develop agripreneurs in rural economy.

3.1.6 Farmers Producer organization:

KARRTABYA integrate farmers with their common interest to form CIGs in each village & open their group bank account. In a regular phase out PGs were motivated & sensitized through focused group discussion, Farmers meeting, general body meeting & administrative meetings. The FPO is named as “Ghumra Seeds Producer Company Ltd”. The common business activity of the group is Paddy seeds production & processing. The project is being supported by NABARD, SFI, IDBI bank. Currently there are 642 members in 25 groups in 28 villages.



3.2 Employable Skill Training to Youths:

KARRTABYA was provided training to youth in 2 trades. One trade is computer skill training and another is driving. Therefore 4 youths are taking admission at Utkal computer academy for DCA course and 4 youths were getting driving training at Kalahandi Motor driving institute, Junagarh. Those two trades will definitely provide them financial opportunity.



3.3 Promotion of the grain bank for the farmers club:

Grain bank is very important of every farmer so KARRTABYA was promotion of the grain bank for the farmers. In the Grain bank total 2 units achieved in this year. After the formation of the farmers club Promotion of the grain bank program was conducted. On that program we had selected 32 farmers who have small land and we provide 2 kg green gram to each farmers. Total 64 kg green gram was provided to them.



3.4 Formation and strengthening the Farmers club:

KARRTABYA was achieved total 6 units in this year. Kalahandi district is basically famous for agriculture and its culture. Most of the



populations of this area are depending upon farming for maintaining their livelihood constraints. Due to collecting of seeds there are formation 3 farmer's clubs at the three villages.

4. CHILD DEVELOPMENT

Family Based Care:

Family is a primary place where a child growth and development is starting. Children who are healthy, well – nourished and protected from abuse and exploitation in family. It creates a favorable environment for development of the children and also creates socialization. Many time children are coming under poverty, hunger, Education, discrimination, abuse, neglect, exploitation, and these children deserve special care & protection. Taking the issue of concerned family based care can be the solution. KARRTABYA has been focusing to rehabilitative of Children who need care & protection through family focused alternative care arrangements such as – Kinship care, foster care, sponsorship etc. where protect and Development of the children.

4.1 Capacity Building of Children:

KARRTABYA was formed and strengthening 38 children club. Where a child participates create his/her own identity. Now children are become more organized and a sense of responsibility has been gradually developing within them. This year KARRTABYA was conducted training to children on

- ❖ Club management
- ❖ Child rights
- ❖ Increase decision making capacity
- ❖ Life skill education both Girls and Boys
- ❖ Exposure visit of Child club members
- ❖ Leadership development
- ❖ Good hygiene practice



4.2 Child led Social Mobilization Programmes:

- ❖ Village cleanness drive back to school campaign.
- ❖ Safety toilet use.
- ❖ Rally against Drop out.
- ❖ Creation of child friendly environment.
- ❖ Rally on Anti Child Labour Day.

4.3 Child's Participation:

4.3.1 Creative and innovative letter writing:

KARRTABYA was conducted a new innovative programme in that programme total 66 sponsored and enrolled children were actively participated from 3 villages. Discussion was held on how to write a better letter with drawing. Basically we were oriented them for two types of letter writing one is applicable for study purpose and another is applicable for project purpose. On the spot the children are wrote letter based on the orientation. At list some students are able to write letter independently in a qualitative way.



4.3.2 Scribbling Competition for 3-5 years children:

Scribbling competition objective was to enhance the participation of 3-5 years children that programme total 18 units achieved in this year. Total 313 of 3-5 year children were participated in scribbling competition from 4 villages. Best 3 children from each village were selected for prizes.



4.3.3 Organizing different indoor competitions for School children:



The activity was implemented in 22 villages. Total 836 of school children were participated in different indoor competition from 15 villages. Different indoor competition like essay, letter writing, debate, song etc. was organized in the junior and senior category. Three from junior and three from senior groups had won prizes.

4.3.4 SRIS & other child focused training:

KARRTABYA was conducted SRI & other child focused training total 2 units achieved in this year. Where, 38 participants were participated. Discussion was held on Sponsor Relation Information System with special focused on Child Communication CVS, CPR, and RAM etc. and all are directly involved with children .The focal points are on POCSO act 2012 (Protection of Children from Sexual Offence) and other child protection issues child marriage, child abuse, child dropout, child right etc.



4.3.5 Children's day celebration:

A mega program was organized by KARRTABYA in Borguda play ground where all school of operational area students were participated in different event. Children of the project area got an opportunity to perform in front of a huge audience.

4.4 Child Protection:

KARRTABYA always believe on Child protection so the Organization total 11 VLCPC has been formed within 3 year by ACC project. Among of them 8 VLCPC are in partially active condition and rest 3 are in formation stage. They were strengthened through monthly meetings. The Project staffs are oriented and imparted training them on alternative forms of child care for their better understanding on different child related issues and functional aspects of child protection mechanism such as:- ICPS, DCPU, CWC and JJB for their knowledge enhancement on the same. All the staffs of everybody know about are aware on their role and responsibilities towards vulnerable children, able to identifying the children who need care and protection in the society.

4.4.1 Protecting Playing Rights of girls:

In our society girls are considering as the burden of family. So people are always they have no rights for playing as like as boys. So keep the above points ChildFund India has initiated one wonderful program only for girls. KARRTABYA was conducted that programme 32 girls were participated. The best three participants of each event were awarded with cup and certificate by the invited guests.



4.4.2 Celebration of special day at block level for Stop violence against children:

On dated 14th November 2015 Children's Day was celebrated as special day on the theme on "Stop violence against children". A large number of audiences were participated there and encouraged to children. Mr. Samit Kumar Pal, PC LS-2, Mr. Akil Khan FO, ChildFund, Mr. MarkanadNaik, Chair Person KARRTABYA, Mr. Shankar Prasad Jued, and SamitiSavya were attended program as the honorable guest of that day.



4.4.3. Changes among Duty bearers & service provider:

KARRTABYA always believes in sustainable change. So organization formation PLCPC and VLCPC are working in different community. The main source of the activities the service provider who is proving the service the stakeholders such as

- CWC, DCPU has been come forward for working together to address alternative care arrangement for the children who need care & protection.
- Both the district and block administration have recognized and encouraging our activities at different forum.
- At field level AWW, ASHA, Teachers are now more conscious and emphatic on child Rights issue.
- The public representatives (PRIs) are now serious about the child right issues and include this in their meeting agenda for constructive discussion.
- The Civil society has been engaged in vulnerable mapping and monitoring to the beneficiary family and taking advocacy initiative for the children.

Best Practices:

- ❖ Our project works on all the children besides vulnerable children, so that every child of the village goes to school regularly and drop out students are counseled and enrolled in suitable school.
- ❖ Sponsorship amount given to the family through account payment and families are Assisting by VLCPC to withdraw money as per need.
- ❖ Promoting community involvement in project activities.
- ❖ Involvement of community in project planning and decision making process.
- ❖ Stake holders aware of requirements needed for the children development. So we give them full scope in decision making that's why Stakeholders dedicate themselves for the development of the locality.
- ❖ We ensure the Right to property to each vulnerable Child.
- ❖ The VLCPC try to link more and more families with Govt. social security scheme by VLCPC.
- ❖ The stake holders disseminate the information on Alternative child care not only in operational area but also everywhere, wherever they go.

5.1 Women Empowerment

Women empowerment is very important so KARRTABYA always believe empowerment of women. Beginning of the organization we have focused on women empowerment through formation and linkage of SHGs with the different agencies whose are support of KARRTABYA like NABARD, ICAR&ChildFund India.

5.1 Organized Sensitization meeting on gender related issues:

In India, discriminatory attitude towards men and women have existed for generations and affect the lives of both genders. Although the constitution of India has granted men and women equal rights, gender disparity still remains. Gender discrimination violates human rights. These are mostly seen in family land sharing among sisters and brothers. So to minimize this discrimination KARRTABYA has implemented this programme in five villages where 65 enrolled and 46 non enrolled participants were aware regarding the gender discrimination and gender related issues.



5. LOCAL GOVERNANCE:

6.1 Capacity building of CBOs:

KARRTABYA was strengthened different committees SHG, Village Development committee, Village Level Child Protection Committee, Youth Club, Children Club, SMC, Health committee (GKS), Farmers committee, Parents committee etc.

6.2 Training to Youth on govt. schemes and services:

KARRTABYA was conducted the training to Youth on govt. schemes and services and achieved total 4 units in this year. Through this program 71 youths from 4 villages were gained knowledge regarding different govt. schemes and services such as: Old Age Pension, Disable scheme, Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Schemes (MGNREGS), Sarva Sikhya Avijan (SSA), Mid-day meal schemes (MDMS), National Rural Health Mission (NRHM), Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM), Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS), Prime Minister's Gram SadakYojana (PMGSY), Indira Awas Yojana (IAY), Rajiv Gandhi Grameen Vidyuti karan Yojana (RGGVY) and also conduct a survey on job card holder under MGNREGS.
