KARRTABYA (Klahandi Association for Rural Re-construction and Total Awareness Benefit of Youth Action) a renowned non-profit, non-Government voluntary organization of Kalahandi came to existence in the year 1990. It was formed by a group of youths of Kalahandi, who were the members of the local youth club; involved in various organizational and developmental activities of the village. # **Education**

With the title of *South Odisha Initiative Education Programme* was started in the Year March 2015 with the technical, moral & financial Support by the TATA TRUSTS in Th.Rampur Block of Kalahandi district. The core objective of the project is to bring about improved learning competencies of primary level children In 40 Primary Schools of 5 GP an additionally, the project also present in 34 Anganwadi centers and supporting to the children through pre schooling activity and ITE schools have been identified to be rolled out in 5 Secondary schools children will be benefitted through the ITE intervention.

## **Pre-School activities**

This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> year we are presence in 34 pre-school (Anganwadi) centres where 1201 children enrolled since July-2017 out of that 195 children achieved grade appropriate milestone and mainstreamed at neighbour school in class-I. This we are we are focus on more TLM for the students and Our volunteers are follow the New Arunima guide involving some new methodology and its effective for the children's, also the children are enjoyed the pre-classes. Pre-school is one of our major focus area it's an opportunities for the age group of 3 to 6 who directly engaged in the education



process. During last 2.5 year we have achieved many target through pre-schooling the major achievement is now 90% of the children enjoying pre-schooling in their own building, it's a really big achievement for the children of Th.rampur. Beside that the most of the AWW also involved in the process with our ECC volunteers it's appreciable.

## **Education in primary Schools**

We continue our intervention in 40 Primary schools since last 2.5 year till April- we have 2386 student out of that 552 children mainstreamed to class 6<sup>th</sup>, 83 students take admission in other TRW schools and newly 331 children admission in class-I so now we have covered 2086 children in 40 intervention schools. In these 6 months we are focus with children for developing their beyond the text books like create interest scientifically temperament, gain knowledge on nature, dynamics of their culture, traditional food practices and way of traditional livelihood, these



activities are specially highlighted in the occasion of summer vacation. We found children are taking more interest on these activities and their participation level was high and they gave their interest towards school with a joyful mood.

We have also given importance for developing their learning improvement through ongoing



class room system and priorities to follow the MGML process and time to time changes our strategy. During last 4 months we have facing some challenges because of heavy rain in our operation area about 80% of the schools are sinking water from roof and children are not even space for sitting because of this the attendance percentage was found low at some villages.

#### **Running of Special coaching Class**

To ensure quality education project has continuing 3 tuition center in those area where govt. system is fail to reach. 86 children from Pipalguda, Dainiguda,& Borguda got education through tuition center. 3 tuition centers are running in 3 interior villages where the education facilities are very poor. In each center there is a teacher,





# **Health & Nutrition**

**Health Checkup:** KARRTABYA always considers health to be an integral part of education and accordingly addresses the health care needs of the children along with their families to ensure good health. This not only leads to a decrease in the drop outs, but also a lead makes the children more active and participatory in the class room. The health checkup programme organized by KARRTABYA with the support of SKN on dated 24.03.2017 at Bor guda KARRTABYA office Premises, where 86 children along with 13 parents were treated by Dr. Paramananda Pujari, Child Specialist and got medicine. A health card was developed for all children for tracking the health condition of the child regularly.



#### **Create awareness programme against early marriage (Street play)**

Early marriage destroys children's lives. The rate of child marriage is very high in western Odisha. It is very difficult for people to see that it is wrong, because there are many causes. Street play is an excellent way of communicating or aware the people. It helps to aware the people why Child marriage is so harmful and we have to stop that. That's why KARRTABYA has organized street play to stop early marriage in 20 operational villages in local languages so that people can easily understand.



On that day community people are aware the legal age for the marriage, before that age children are not physically, emotionally or mentally ready to be married. Early marriage means the end of education and the end of childhood; Girls bodies are not yet ready to become wives, mothers for carry children. They risk dangerous complication in pregnancy and childbirth. It promotes the rate of MMR & IMR. Child marriage is wrong. It must be stopped.

The following massages are given to the people through street play like:

- Child marriage experiences a higher incidence of domestic violence, marital abuse (Including physical, sexual or psychological abuse) and abandonment.
- ❖ Child marriage increases maternal mortality and Infant mortality rates.

## Organized food festival-

During the summer camp we have organizes many food festival programme at different places. It was really a nice programme where the children and community people actively participated and involved. The objective of the programme was to protect the traditional food of the community and teach them about the protein and the hygiene part



of the food. Children and community brings lot of traditional cooked food, forestry food and many more at a place and eagerly discussed about it and how they cooked it, how they protect, harvest etc.





## Develop Kitchen Garden.

On 05.07.2017 total 60 families were provided with various kind of plant such as- Tomato, Brinjal, Chilli, Guava, Drumstick, Papaya, Beans. On that time they also get knowledge and techniques on preparation for cultivation. After the successful practice of kitchen garden all the families became able to get organic and fresh vegetables from their backyard, also Increase consumption of green vegetable in their regular diet, which ultimately strengthen the health and nutrition of the children.



### Know your food grow your food

This programme was organized at Budhidara and Borguda GP of Junagarh Block where total 72 caregivers got knowledge on adequate fooding practice, hygienic practice and preparation of food at home. The care givers got able to enhanced their knowledge on adequate feeding practice, for that the rate of visits to the health centre, Medical costs, Less days that children are sick at home and cannot go to school has been reduced.



# Improve the capacity of Adolescent/Peer support group in addressing ASRH and early marriage issue.

This programme was organized both for adolescent boys and girls in 2 phases in Dedara G.P office where 77 adolescent boys and girls enhance the knowledge on Adolescent reproductive sexual health.



Adolescent boys and girls are gained knowledge on – Who is adolescent, why focused on adolescent health, Reproductive Health, Healthy practices in relationship, STD, Hygiene and Healthy living dream, Critical thinking, coping with stress, strategy for promotion of adolescent health etc.

## **Participation of Children**

## **Summer camp**

This Programme is continuing from 1<sup>st</sup> of May to 20<sup>th</sup> of June-2017 around 50 days. This is the programme where the participation across all the community members involving out of school children who enrolled in other school and came back to home during summer vacation who actively involved in the summer camp activities. This year around 350 other school children are participated in the summer course programme.



**Objective of Summer Course**-: The key objective of the programme is to engage the children in summer vacation and give them some new knowledge which is not covered

**Focus in this summer camp**- We focus in this camp to create interest among the children on hands on science activities as well as nature & traditional education which is gradually deprived.


**Impact**- There is no doubt the children are enjoying a lot during the camp, more than 90% of attendance in the centre and most of the children actively participated in the programme which is lacking during academic classes. They learn and able to prepare lot of hands on science toys beside this they able to learn on different herbal and medicinal plants through nature study.






## Celebration of children's day

Every child is special and every child has some inherent







## Rally on RTE by Child club

Child Club members had conducted rally campaign in 20 operational villages to make education a reality to every child by implementing the RTE Act in full force by the support of SKN. The community people were aware through slogan, ply card, poster etc. Also on that day the child club members collected Grievance from the school and submit that grievance at Panchayat office. Around 600 child club members in 20 villages from different child club were participated in that rally; the participants are raising slogans and holding placards to



aware and spread the information to community about the importance of education. They explained villagers how education would make the next generation informed, empowered and prosperous through different slogans. The Rally was taken out to encourage parents to send their children to school.

They also counsel those parents who are not sending their children to school. After some days we came to know that the rally really affects some of the families and children. Some children and parents are self motivated to send their children to school after regular counseling by VCPC members.

## Awareness programme on Stop Child labour

Two days awareness campaign was organized in different villages of Dundelmal, Dedara and Budhidara G.P of Junagarh block on the event of international child Labour Day to eliminate against the child labour. The objective was to sensitize privileged citizens to prevent the practice of children labour and instead empower them with the power of education. More than 300 children are participated in that rally. In that programme the local youths, large no. of C.C member, Teacher, Village leader, VLCPC representative, ASHA, AWW, PRI member, SHG members were actively participated in that Rally and the respective Sarpanch flagging off the rally.

## Youth Empowerment through skill development

## **Vocational Training to the Adolescent Enrolled Children or sibling**

10 girls (Siblings of direct beneficiary's children) were trained on tailoring for 3 months. Sewing machine and kits were provided to start their own little business. After got that training they start their own business. Amazingly they earn 150 to 200/- per day. At occasion time they earned more comparison to normal day. Somehow it helps them for family maintenance.







#### ITE (Integrated Approach of Technology in Education)

We are working ITE activities in 4 high schools of Th.Rampur block; the purpose of the ITE Programme is to link the different technology with the ongoing syllabus and enhancing the knowledge of the students about the subject with knowledge deepening. Specially we focus on the syllabus subject and make different project using of Multimedia, Spread sheet, PPT and Digital story beside this internet is one of the key tolls where the student browsing as and when required as per the requirement of the subject.





Initially we making project with class VI to Class IX since August 2017 but till August we are focusing on the Class IX only involving 215 students and make project at least 2 projects in each class every month. During last 6 month we have make 44 Projects at 4 Schools.

## **Agriculture Training Assistance (ATA) program**

The Programme Known as Agriculture Technology Assistant (ATA). Training Module design in a joint effort with the involvement of expert from Collage of Agriculture, KVK, SFI and Agriculture & Horticulture department, For imparting training the resources Person from CA, KVK, SFI and Agriculture & Horticulture to the Trainees, After Training inviting to the employer for engagement of trainees. Support service also given to the ATA for self reliance and to be an entrepreneur.





Till now we have conducted 5 Batches have successfully completed where 130 students had undergone screening process with 87 candidates were selected for ATAT and 56 candidates were registered for 45 days residential training programme. From the successful candidate of 87, 11 are ready to take up Agrientrepreneurship in their locality. Total 5 numbers of ATAT exposures team with 71 candidates (Jharkhand-18, AP-40 and Bihar-

13) visited Kalahandi project and 1 team from Odisha visited to Ranchi project with 8

## **Promotion of Agriculture Entrepreneur**

- Development of Entrepreneur for Agri input, Nursery Management, seed organizer.

## **Training to Youth Volunteers on preparing science toys**

Mr. Ashok Rupner and Shivaji Mane from IUCAA, Pune joined as trainer in the workshops. The training focused on how to make science toys which is handmade and e available low cost/no cost materials. They used several tricks behind preparing toys that are scientific facts. Govt. Primary and Upper Primary 41 School teachers and 39 Education Volunteers were present in the program.



The main objective of this program was student will learn science joyfully by preparing science toys which contain scientific fact and practically doing several activities.



Participants were provided materials which were very low cost and taught how to prepare different activities. With the help of resource persons all participants could able to do waves using straw ,cap in different shape and size using news paper, centric fugal force using balloons, paper fish and fan, air pressure, repulsion, balancing, simple motors etc

#### **COMMINITY AWARENESS PROGRAMME**

After the launching School & Community Science van it's an opportunity to create more awareness among the community through a different way. In this connection we have organize 26 community awareness programmes in different villages with the help of School & Community Science van. The response was excellent communities are excited to know about the vehicle and its activities. When the vehicle was reached at the village there is huge gathering at the place and we get the benefit and shared some ongoing



issue in front of the community and finally shows some motivational and awareness videos.

## **Training to the volunteers on Math**

Math training was arranged on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> of May 2017 at Th.Rampur revenue bungalow. All education volunteers, project key staffs of KARRTABYA were participated in this training, Resource persons from SIKSHYASANDHAN Bhubaneswar taken the two days session.

They taught pre math concept to fraction by using several TLM such as egg cartoon, sticks, leafs, judo block, flowers, pellet, cold drinks cap, pebble, Mali etc and build the confidence of all volunteers.



**Impact**- The impact of the training was most of the volunteers follow maximum TLM when they teach the subject of Math as well as the concept clarity among the volunteers. The students are easy to receive the new methodology of teaching and its helps the students to understand math. Some EVs are able to teach other volunteers also govt. teachers are adopted our methodology.

## **Child Development**

#### **Family Based Care**

Family is the nucleus of the society and children are the nucleus of the family. In fact children are regarded as the future of nation and hence a well brought up child would be a responsible citizen and an asset to the nation and can take the nation forward.

However there are many misfortunate children in Kalahandi District who are deprived of parental care, love and affection because some of them have lost their parents, some of them have become subject to child abuse, abandonment or negligence due to various socio-economic reasons. In such cases the children found themselves in a state of rejection, loneliness and are in need of care and protection.

There are certain limitations in overall development of children in child care institutions such as;

- > a child can stay in CCI until he attains 18 years of age
- > the child faces difficulties in adjusting himself with the new environment after he is deinstitutionalized from the CCI at once.
- The emotional remoteness of child with the family members gradually increases which later on creates a gap in the family bonding.

- ➤ The child gets away from the family and social values as he stays in a confined environment and do not come into a social interaction.
- > Child feels less responsible for the family.

## So KARRTABYA Always Belives that :-

- A child can be compared with clay and it is in the hand of a potter how they shapes the clay.
- Family is the primary unit for the growth and welfare of the children.
- Every Child has the right to a family.
- The child's interest are of the paramount importance.
- Institutional care should only be a solution of last resort.

Keeping the beliefs in mind KARRTABYA activities focus on :-

**Sponsorship Program:** 100 children who need care and protection along with their 149 siblings from Junagarh block are being supported with the support of SKN. Individual care plan, Home study report & education report of each child prepared and analyzed. Rs. 1000.00 per month has been given to the family and utilized to meet the immediate need of child.



**Capacity Building of Children:** KARRTABYA has formed and strengthening 31 children club. It is one of the foremost platforms for the children where they get opportunity to show their inherent talent, discussed their issues, collectively take action. Now children are become more

organized and a sense of responsibility has been gradually developing within them. This year KARRTABYA imparted training to children on

- Leadership development
- Club management
- Child rights
- Good hygiene practice,
- Life skill education

# Orientation programme to C.C leader on breaking the culture of silence against Child abuse.

The programme was organized at Dedara and Budhidara G.P of Junagarh blocks where adolescent boys and girls from different villages of respective G.P had participated in that programme Tot al 188 children from different child club were gained knowledge on POCSO Act 2012. Children are learned: - Good touch and bad touch, High risk symptoms, Types of harassment, how to protect from sexual abuse, what to do during harassment.



## Training to care giver association on Child Care and protection



KARRTABYA ACC project was organized a programme on training to caregiver association on child care and protection by the support of SKN. 2 units have covered as per planning on 02.08.2017 and 03.08.2017 in Dedara and Budhidara G.P Total 65 Participant was participated in that programme and Mr. Ajay Mishra, CWC Chair Person Kalahandi as Resource person for that training. He adopted different method such as – group discussion, brain storming, etc.

The caregivers are sensitize about the issues of child protection and their role and responsibility through child, and aware about the plan and programme of Govt. and effective legal protection for the children.

# Livelihood

#### Livelihood support to needy family

This most needy family are getting this support also what kind of support they will get, decided by VCPC. Through this support the family has economically gradually been flourishing, it indicates from-children are getting better education, caregiver are saving money in SHG, able to repay the previous loan, do not depends upon other family for family maintenance.



## **HSP-Paddy**



- During the year of 2017-18 a total of 250 growers taken up Hybrid seed production on 364 acres in 29 villages of the project area. Total production of seed was 397.06 MT whose value was INR 18.3 Million
- > There are three seed producer companies viz. Bayer Crop Science, US Agriseeds, Nirmal seeds and Mahyco were associated with the program.

#### **FPO Development**

- Land has been purchased for establishment of seed processing plant .Size of land is 0.78 acre whose value was INR 195000.
- ➤ Detail Project Report (DPR) has been completed and it has been submitted to agriculture dept. for Govt. subsidy.

#### **Credit Linkage**

During this year total KCC provided by IDBI branches to our outreach was 195.


Market -LED EXTENSION (MLE): Market led Extension which addressed the issue of market access and led to a direct improvement in farm income. A ready available market helps the marketer for easy deliverance of farm produce.

- ➤ In 2017-18, 986 farmers with 686.6 acre were linked with collective market in through 5 no. Of AE.
- ➤ Total Business Turnover was **INR.8740922.00** which was eye catching and this could possible due to the efforts of team member and AEs.



#### **Irrigation Structure (Hydro Water Turbine)**

- ➤ With the joint efforts of IIT Jodhpur and SFI water turbine has been installed successfully in "Haller-jore" at Kelia to help the farmer in providing irrigation for vegetable farming.
- ➤ It has the capacity to lift water up to 12 meter height & 200 meter of radius. Different model of pump can be attached to increase its efficiency of irrigation.
- ➤ It can also perform other task such as generating micro power, grind flour by attaching some accessories as per requirement



> One more advantage is to save the cost of cultivation by 10-12k against fuel cost.



#### **Trial-Demonstration and other Activity**

- ➤ DSR was a pilot programme taken by 4 farmers in 4.5 acre area with an average yield of 13.5 Quintal /acre (maximum of 20 Quintal).
- ➤ Bitter gourd variety VNR 75078, 72038, 75075 from VNR seed was taken for in 40 dismal areas by 2 farmers and the average yield was 140kg/cent.



- A trial on Black Gram Variety of "SARADA" from West Bengal was taken up by 10 farmers in 6 acre area for seed multiplication purpose with an average yield was 1.5 quintal by line sowing & 80 kg through broadcasting method.
- > Speed Kompost Trial by 20 farmers- Quality compost in 90 days.
- ➤ Kharif campaigning was held with the existed and new AEs to scale up the extension services to the outreach farmers. Total village covered 179 & Farmers Touched 14322.
